

12 THINGS YOU CAN DO

IF YOU ENCOUNTER ANTISEMITISM IN COLLEGE

- 1 Call campus security and the police if you are physically threatened or there is a call for violence.
- 2 Call campus security if you encounter a swastika or other antisemitic graffiti. In the absence of available campus security, call the police.
- 3 If it is safe, document the scene by taking pictures or a video with time and date stamp.



- 4 Reach out to Stand With Us for guidance.
- 5 Reach out to a trusted religious adviser at your school's Hillel or Chabad.
- 6 Report it to reportcampushate.org and stopantisemitism.org.

- 7 Report the incident as a bias using your school's reporting procedure.
- 8 Ask campus administrators to publicly condemn the incident.
- 9 Organize an event with like-minded students to condemn the incident.
- 10 Write an op-ed for your student newspaper.
- 11 Reach to your parents for guidance.
